## BYLAW No. 154

---

A bylaw to delegate the power to exempt a parcel from the statutory or bylaw minimum frontage to the approving officer.

---

Under the *Local Government Act*, a local government may delegate the power to exempt a parcel from the statutory or bylaw minimum frontage to the approving officer.

The Council of the District of Sooke, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw is cited as *Delegation of Authority Bylaw No. 1, 2003*.
2. The power to exempt a parcel from the statutory or bylaw minimum frontage is delegated to the Approving Officer.

Introduced and read a first time the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 2003.

Read a second time the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 2003.

Read a third time the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 2003.

Adopted by affirmative vote of 2/3<sup>rds</sup> of the votes cast on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December 2003.
