TERMS OF REFERENCE

Council Adoption: January 28, 2013 Amended by Council: March 9, 2015

Standing Committee Name: EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE

Established: March 12, 2012

Purpose of Committee:

The purpose of the Select Committee on Emergency Planning is to provide recommendations to Council regarding matters related to the planning, development, maintenance, implementation and training of all aspects of emergency management within the District of Sooke.

Role of Committee:

The Committee will, consistent with the general purpose above, provide recommendations to Council on various Emergency Planning matters including but not restricted to the following:

- Emergency Supplies
- Communications
- Public Education
- · Recruitment and Training
- Budget

Membership:

- a. The Emergency Planning Committee is established under the guidance of the District of Sooke Emergency Program Coordinator. The Committee consists of one (1) member of Council and representatives from the following decision making agencies who would be involved in the mitigation, planning and response to emergencies within District of Sooke:
 - District of Sooke Fire Department (Fire Chief)
 - RCMP
 - Emergency Health Services
 - Emergency Social Services
 - School District No. 62 (Sooke)
 - Sooke Amateur Radio (as part of emergency program)
 - Emergency Coordinator Representatives:
 - o Juan de Fuca
 - Metchosin

b. The following may serve the committee in a resource, non-voting capacity:

• Emergency Program Coordinator

• Emergency Social Services Coordinator

Term: One (1) year in accordance with Policy No. 1.4.,
