# Sooke OCP Review 2020

## 1.0 Question #1

For delivery of the proposal, are there any special instructions related to where/how to deliver the USB stick (i.e. will the District Office reception counter be open to receive deliveries, or will there be alternative drop off arrangements)?

**Answer:** While the District of Sooke office is currently closed to the public, our reception desk is open. Couriered/hand delivered packages are being received as usual.

#### 2.0 Question #2
