Your puppy is not ready for the park until they are at least four months old and fully vaccinated.



All dogs must be wearing a current dog licence tag.

## Nelcome! Paws at the Park



Keep your leash with you. Even in off-leash parks, you may need to remove your dog from a situation (e.g. excited play and aggressive dog interactions).



Remove excessively loud or aggressive dogs immediately.





Be cautious with dog toys, or don't bring them. Be mindful if your dog is not keen to share.



**Owners are legally** responsible for the behaviour of their dog(s) at all times.



Securely latch gate after entering and exiting.






