Please be advised that weather depending, Windley Contracting will be activating Highway 14 Connie Road to Glinz Lake Road construction phases the week of July 18, 2022, to ensure completion of the final highway design. The phase(s) will include lane shifts and traffic pattern changes. Highway traffic will be shifted onto the new west bound lanes and Gillespie traffic will be directed to use the Gillespie Connector which will take them under the newly constructed bridge. Please see attached drawing. During construction motorists can expect delays.

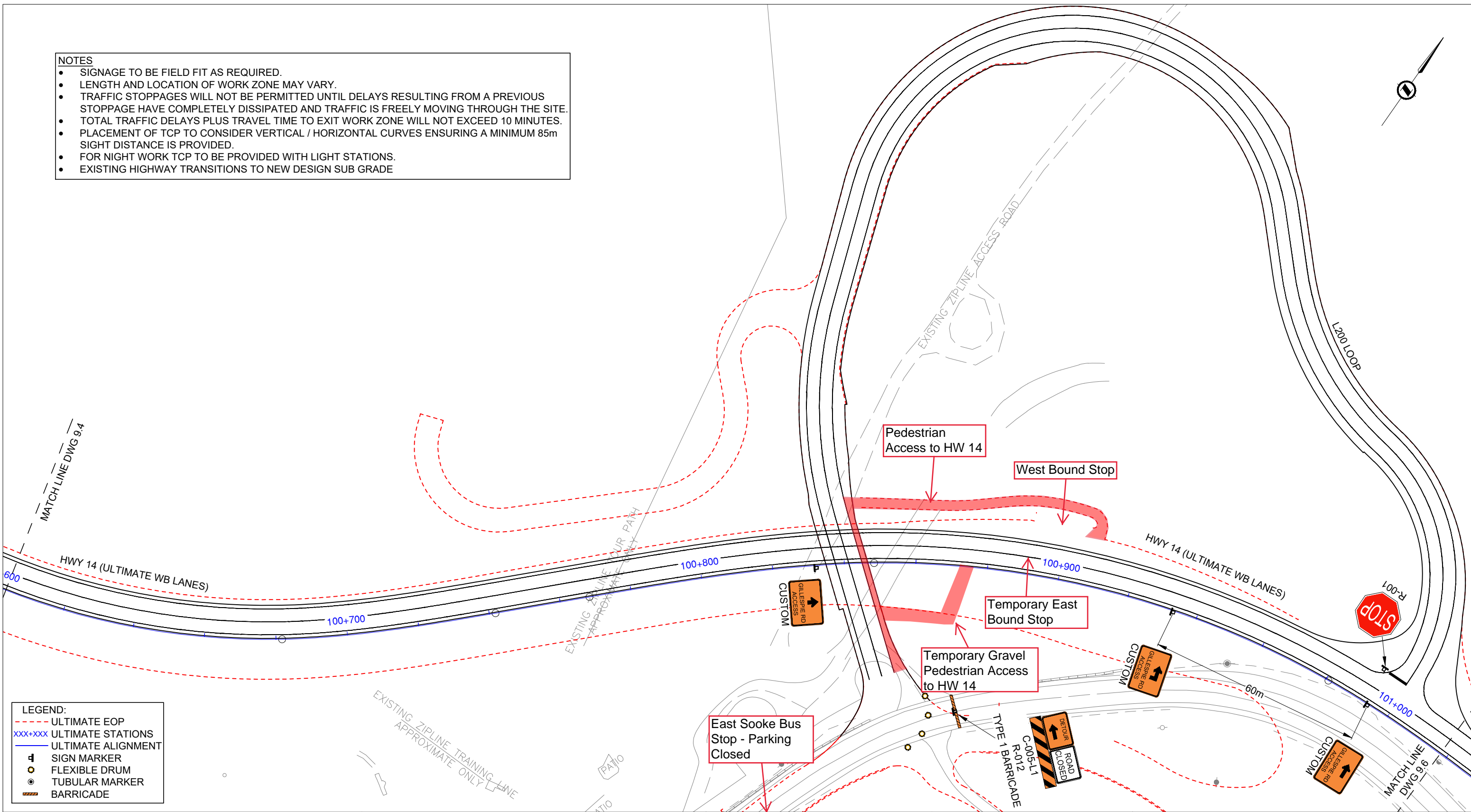

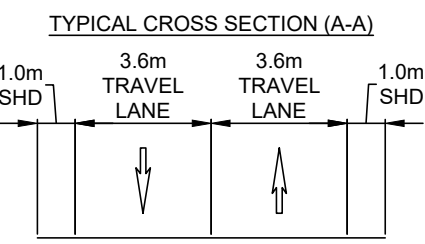

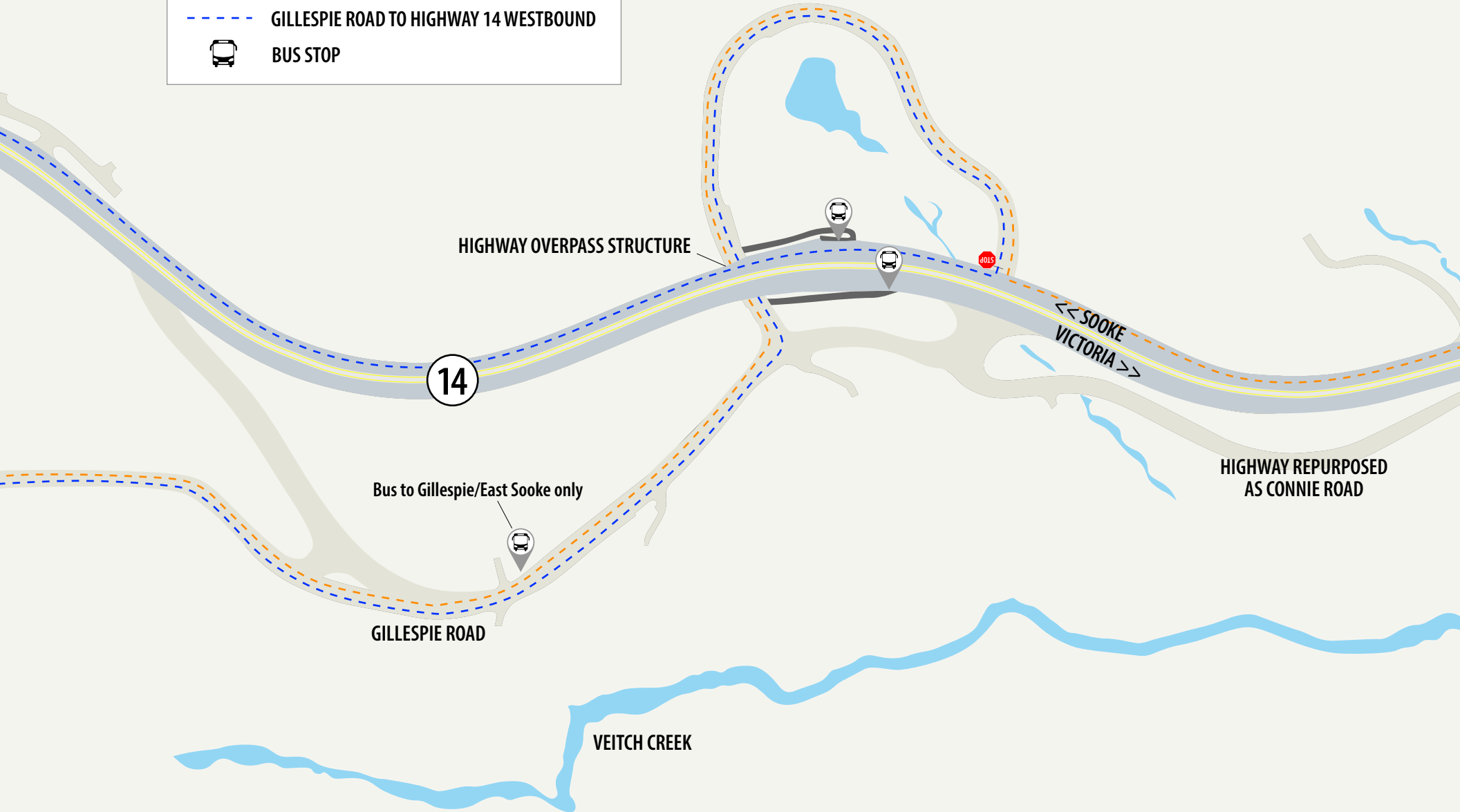
