

SEA WALK URBAN TRAIL

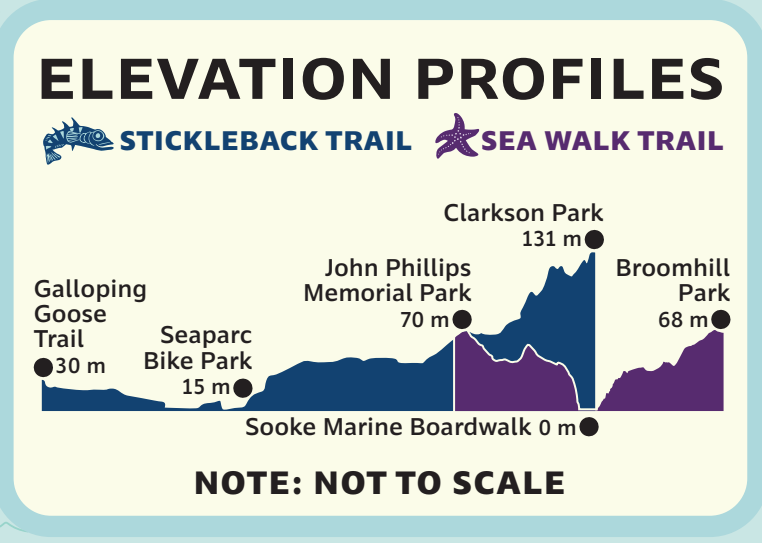
The symbol of the Sea Walk is a Sea Star which can be found clinging to rocks, amongst eelgrass and in tide pools in the intertidal zone in the Sooke Basin.



The 4.3 km Sea Walk Urban Trail connects the Sooke Marine Boardwalk & Rotary Pier and Ed Macgregor Park to John Phillips Memorial Park and the Stickleback Urban Trail. This loop route uses foot trails and sidewalks to link the waterfront to the heart of Sooke. We hope you enjoy your walk!

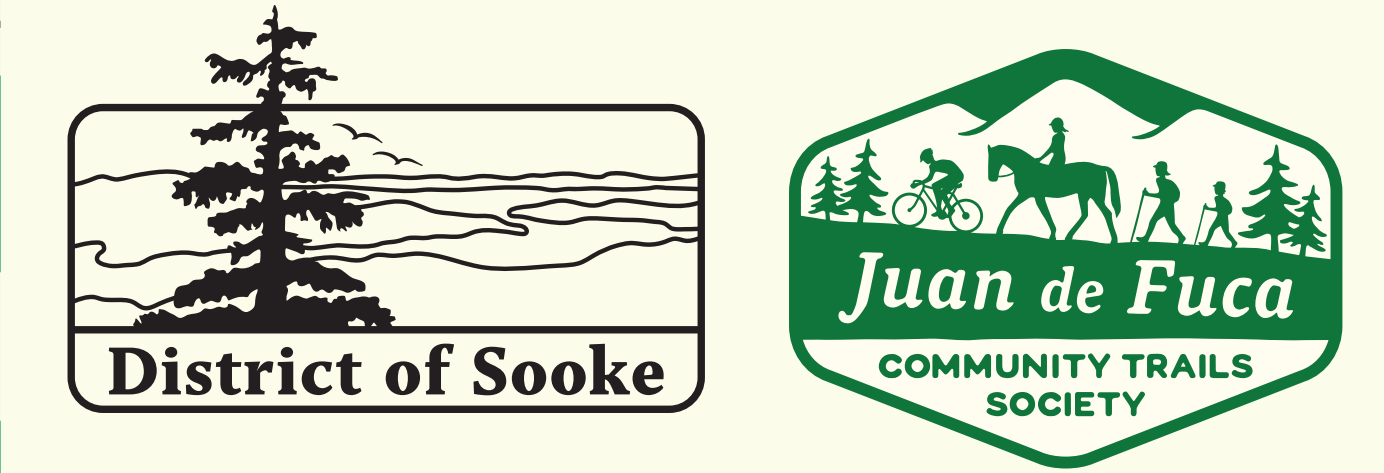
