BYLAW No. 239

A bylaw to provide for a fire protection local area service for the Silver Spray fire protection local service area.

Under the Supplementary Letters Patent issued December 2, 2004, a local area service for the newly enclosed area was declared for the purpose of fire protection and these Supplementary Letters Patent were deemed to be the bylaw establishing the municipal local area service.

Pursuant to the Supplementary Letters Patent, the District of Sooke must adopt a bylaw under section 211 of the *Community Charter* with respect to the fire protection local area service.

The Council of the District of Sooke, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw is cited as *Silver Spray Fire Protection Local Area Service Bylaw, 2006*.

2. In this bylaw,

Silver Spray Fire Protection Local Service Area means the area of the District of Sooke established by the Supplementary Letters Patent issued December 2, 2004; and

Fire Protection Service means the service of fire prevention and suppression and emergency response.

4. The District of Sooke establishes a fire protection service for the benefit of the Silver Spray Fire Protection Local Service Area.

5. The boundaries of the Silver Spray Fire Protection Local Service Area are the boundaries of the area newly enclosed within the District of Sooke by the Supplementary Letters Patent issued December 2, 2004.

6. All of the costs of the Fire Protection Service must be recovered by a local service property value tax imposed on both land and improvements within the Silver Spray Fire Protection Local Service Area.
